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## ***Introduction***

In today's complex and ever-changing health care market, consumers are becoming more responsible for their own health care, including its costs. This guide provides hospital service information in order to help consumers better understand Maryland's hospital market and make more informed health care purchasing decisions. It also highlights differences in charges among Maryland's hospitals for similar types of inpatient admissions. The charges in this report are annual averages and provided for illustrative purposes only. While this information contains hospital charges, it will not tell you how much you will owe for a hospital stay in which you receive a specific type of care. Your hospital bill may differ from the charges shown in these tables. Your actual bill reflects your use of services during your hospital stay and the hospital's charges at the time of your admission.

## ***All Payer Rate Setting System***

The Health Services Cost Review Commission ("HSCRC" or "commission") was established by the General Assembly in 1971. The Commission's mandate includes reviewing and approving rates that Maryland hospitals can charge for their services and making Maryland hospitals' financial information available to the public. The HSCRC sets rates for all payers including private insurance companies, HMOs, MCOs, Medicare and Medicaid. This system is referred to as the "all-payer" system, in which all payers pay their fair share of hospital costs.

In establishing the HSCRC, the Maryland General Assembly set out to accomplish the following objectives:

- keep hospital services affordable;
- expand access to hospital care for those without insurance; and
- provide accountability for hospital performance to the public and state government

As part of its rate-setting activities, the HSCRC collects data from hospitals, which are used to monitor hospital utilization and charges, as well as to set inpatient rates. These data are used to generate the statistics reported in this guide.

## ***Methodology***

Each hospital admission is grouped into one of 320 "All Patient Refined Diagnosis Related Groups" (APR-DRGs) that classify patients into clinically cohesive categories based on their medical condition and the severity of their illness. The 320 APR-DRGs are separated into four "severity of illness" levels. This guide provides information on the 15 most frequent APR-DRGs as reported in aggregate by Maryland hospitals from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. The number of cases (discharges) is used to determine the 15 most common APR-DRGs. Hospitals' data with fewer than six cases within an APR-DRG are not reported. The 15 most frequent APR-DRGs for all Maryland hospitals combined may or may not be commonly encountered at any particular hospital.

Within the 15 APR-DRGs, the number of cases, the average charge per case, and the average charge per day by Maryland acute hospitals are listed. “Average Charge per Case” is the average charge for cases in the APR-DRG at each hospital after the charge has been weighted by the statewide severity distribution for the APR-DRG (this creates a severity-adjusted average charge). This average charge does not include physician fees. “Average Charge per Day” is the severity adjusted average charge divided by the average length of stay for patients in an APR-DRG at each hospital. Each hospital’s average charge can be affected by a number of factors, including:

- Patients’ severity of illness
- Wage levels and the price of goods and services in its locality
- The amount of teaching it does
- The amount of uncompensated care it provides to patients

The above factors are reflected in the amount that Maryland hospitals are allowed to charge for services. In addition, the average charge for each APR-DRG is weighted by the statewide severity distribution for that category. For example, within APR-DRG 127, cases statewide are distributed as follows:

Level 1 – 15%  
Level 2 – 30%  
Level 3 – 30%  
Level 4 – 25%

At “Hospital A,” average charge for each severity level is illustrated weighted by the statewide distribution as follows:

Level 1 - \$6,000 \* 15% = \$ 900  
Level 2 - \$6,500 \* 30% = \$1,950  
Level 3 - \$7,200 \* 30% = \$2,160  
Level 4 - \$8,000 \* 25% = \$2,000

Total: \$7,010 = weighted average charge for APR-DRG 127

Note: The charges provided are to be used as a guide only. Your hospital bill may differ from the charges shown in these tables. These charges reflect annual averages. Your bill reflects your use of services during your stay and the hospital’s rates at the time of your admission.

Please Note for Charts:

1. An asterisk indicates a cell count less than six.
2. A weighted charge is the average charge per APR DRG with weights being the severity level percent of that APR DRG for the entire state. If there are missing severity levels at a hospital, the formula is modified as follows: Step One: Calculate the fraction of cases in each APR DRG for each severity statewide (“fas”); Step Two: Compute the weighted average charge for each APR DRG for each hospital using (fas) as the weight.
