2015 Annual Quality and Resource Use Reports (QRUR)

- As a GPTN participant NJII Transformation Coaches can help practices access their QRUR which provides the baseline for practice's quality and cost thresholds. Our Transformation coaches assist the practice in identifying high cost patients and low quality measures to improve on. NJII analyzes QRUR exhibits to help determine patients that are attributed to your practices Tax Identification Number (TIN) that can be driving up your cost.
