SCHEDULE FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMANCE REVIEWS

The Maryland Health Care Commission provides the following schedule for the review of applications for Certificates of Conformance to provide elective percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) services: Only the three existing hospitals that currently provide primary PCI services but do not provide elective PCI services and have not been authorized to provide elective PCI services are eligible to apply for a Certificate of Conformance under this Schedule. Those hospitals are Holy Cross Hospital, Howard County General Hospital, and MedStar Franklin Square Medical Center.
