

The Maryland Health Care Commission, an independent agency located within the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, is responsible for planning and regulating the development of a health care system that provides Maryland residents with geographic and financial access to quality health care at a reasonable cost.

August 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018

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The Maryland Health Care Commission has announced the following decisions on applications to build, enlarge, merge, or modify health services or facilities in the State. These decisions were made from August 1, 2018 through September, 2018

Decisions of this nature apply to applications from proposed providers or sponsors seeking MHCC Certification of Need as required by State Law:

During this period the following decisions were made:
▶ 1 project was approved with a cost of \$10,400,000
▶ projects were denied
▶
▶ previously approved project was approved for a modification
▶ approved projects were relinquished by the applicant
▶ 2 projects under review were withdrawn by the applicant with a proposed cost of \$283,240,375
▶ approved projects were voided by the Commission
▶ <u>0</u> approved projects were revoked by the Commission
Also during this period the following occurred:
▶ <u>4</u> approved projects were pre-licensed for First Use or Partial First Use
▶ <u>2</u> new letters of intent was received
▶ <u>11</u> determinations of coverage for Certificate of Need review were made including waiver beds and acquisitions
The MHCC currently has 36 CON applications under review and 32 CON approved projects under development.

MHCC Certification helps assure that new or expanded facilities and services are consistent with the future health care needs of the people of Maryland. All projects certified by this Commission have been found consistent with the State Health Plan and review standard of this Commission.
