**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD
WASHINGTON ADVENTIST HOSPITAL
September 10, 2013**

The undersigned, being the duly appointed Chairman of the Governing Board, Washington Adventist Hospital, a nonprofit hospital pursuant to the laws of the state of Maryland, does hereby certify that the following resolution was adopted by the Washington Adventist Hospital Governing Board on the 10th of September 2013 and which resolution has not been revoked and will remain in full force and effect as the date hereof without modification or amendment in any respect:

WHEREAS, the Maryland Health Care Commission has established the State Health Plan for Facilities and Services: Acute Hospital Inpatient Obstetric Services, COMAR 10.24.12;

WHEREAS, each hospital providing obstetric services in Maryland shall comply with the essential requirements for its level of perinatal program, as defined in the most current version of the Maryland Perinatal System Standards;

WHEREAS, the Maryland Perinatal System Standards revised July 2012, requires the hospital's Board of Directors, administration, and medical and nursing staffs to demonstrate commitment to its specific level of perinatal center designation and to the care of perinatal patients;

WHEREAS, Washington Adventist Hospital has a Level IIB Perinatal Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington Adventist Hospital, its Governing Board, administration and staff agree to meet the Maryland Perinatal System Standards for its specific level of designation, Level IIB Perinatal Program and the hospital bylaws, contracts, budgets – all specific to the perinatal program will be indicative of the hospital's commitment to the financial, human, and physician resources and to the infrastructure that are necessary to support the hospital's level of perinatal program designation, Level IIB.
