

Responsibilities of Attending Cardiac Surgeon Ann Arundel Medical Center

1. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to ensure excellent clinical outcome of the AAMC Cardiac Surgery program.
2. This individual will be directly answerable to the Chief, Division of Cardiac Surgery AAMC, the Chief, Division of Cardiac Surgery JHU; Chairman Department of Surgery at JHU as well as Chief, Department of Surgery Ann Arundel Medical Center.
3. This individual will spend 20 % of his clinical time in activities related to the program at AAMC and 80% of his clinical activities at JHU.
4. This individual will assist with on call responsibilities at AAMC on average no more than 1 night per week and every third weekend and on an as needed basis during vacations.
5. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to:
 - a. Evaluation and accept patients for cardiac surgery
 - b. Performing Cardiac Surgery
 - c. Supervising the post operative management of cardiac surgery patients.
6. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to maintaining a schedule of cardiac surgery attending physicians 24 x 7.
7. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to design and implement cardiac surgery protocols.
8. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery provide programmatic oversight to the AAMC based perfusionists.
9. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to provide programmatic oversight to the AAMC based physician / surgical assistants along with the JHU chief of Cardiac Surgery and JHU Chief of physician / surgical assistants.
10. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to monitor cardiac surgery outcomes including the development of a cardiac surgery specific morbidity and mortality program in conjunction with that of JHU.
11. This individual will work with the AAMC Chief of Cardiac Surgery to develop cardiac surgery specific quality improvement initiatives in conjunction with those of JHU.
12. This individual will work with AAMC leadership on Cardiac Surgery specific community outreach programs in program development, education and fund raising.
13. This individual will work with AAMC cardiology and anesthesia leadership to maintain a seamless integration of cardiology and anesthesia services as they pertain to the performance of cardiac surgery.
14. This individual will help in the training of AAMC staff at JHU for the clinical program at AAMC.
15. This individual will help develop and conduct cardiac surgery clinical research activities.
16. This individual will help to train JHU medical student, resident , fellowship level trainees as they rotate on the Cardiac Surgery service at AAMC.
17. This individual will participate in the education of students and trainees from non-physician medical disciplines as they rotate on the Cardiac Surgery service at AAMC.

18. This individual will fulfill medical staff requirements to maintain privileges in good standing at both AAMC and JHH.
