SUMMARY OF COLLABORATIVE NURSE TRAINING

Purpose - Provide education, training and clinical collaboration in the area of cardiac surgical nursing services

UMMC Responsibilities

Phase I

- Perioperative for 3 months prior to opening program
 - Assessment period UMMC Nurses, perfusionist staff and other clinical personnel will conduct a 1-2 day assessment of the hospital's operating room and support services to evaluate hospital's readiness for cardiac surgery
 - Provide an orientation program at UMMC for hospital staff which will include scrubbing in and obtaining hands on experience with cardiac cases - competency assessments will be conducted for staff during this orientation
 - Provide a shadow program at UMMC in order to observe cardiac surgery services for those RN's who only need a refresher
 - Assist hospital in developing policies, procedures, care protocols, competency education materials checklists and competency verification processes
- ICU/Step Down for 6 months prior to opening program
 - Permit hospital nurses to shadow UMMC nurses for 2 weeks
 - Assist hospital in developing policies, procedures, care protocols competency education materials, checklists and competency verification processes

Phase II - for 3 months after program starts

- Perioperative
 - One UMMC nurse will travel to hospital and work collaboratively with the hospital's cardiac surgery team in the course of a minimum of ten and up to 30 cardiac surgical cases
- ICU/Step Down
 - Each hospital nurse will work up to 12 shifts at UMMC number of shifts will be based on competency of nurse to be assessed by a UMMC preceptor on a weekly basis
 - During each hospital nurse shift they will work collaboratively with UMMC nurses within UMMC Cardiac Surgery ICU to care for at least two post procedure patients per week and one to two shifts in cardiac surgery step down area

Phase III - for 3 months after program starts

- Perioperative
 - UMMC will make at least one member of UMMC's cardiac surgery team available to hospital's cardiac surgery team for clinical and administrative consultation, regarding perioperative services, via telephone or video for an average of four hours per week
- ICU/Step Down
 - During first month of operations, UMMC will make at least four members of UMMC's cardiac surgery team available to the hospital's cardiac surgery team for planned once weekly clinical and administrative consultation, regarding ICU/step down cardiac surgery care, via telephone or video for an average of one hour per week. After the first month, meetings will be scheduled as needed.
