What is a State Designated MSO?

State Designated MSOs are organizations, designated by the Maryland Health Care Commission that provide technical assistance to health care providers (providers) in the adoption and use of health information technology (health IT). State designation ensures the MSO meets benchmarks for service, and privacy and security.

What is an HIE?

HIE enables treating providers to appropriately access and securely share health information electronically. An HIE's goal is to facilitate access to and retrieval of clinical information to provide safer, timelier, efficient, effective patient-centered care. HIE provides the capability to share clinical information between disparate EHRs while maintaining the meaning of the information being exchanged. HIE can help providers avoid readmissions, reduce medication errors, improve diagnoses, and decrease duplicate testing.
