**LEVEL II CENTERS:** Maximum hours have increased to 24,500 per year or 12, 250 per 6 month semi annual filing period for Level II Trauma Centers. The RCE factor has also been increased from .20 to .30 effectively increasing on-call reimbursement by 50 percent per on-call hour.

**LEVEL III CENTERS:** Maximum hours have increased to 35,040 per year or 17,520 per 6 month semi annual filing period for Level III Trauma Centers. The RCE factor increased from .30 to .35 effectively increasing on-call reimbursement by about 17 percent per on-call hour. Level III Trauma Centers for the Non-Metropolitan Areas (Cumberland & Salisbury) increased to \$554,028 for a 6 month filing period and Level III Trauma Centers for Metropolitan Areas less than one million (Hagerstown) increased to \$628,600 for a 6 month filing period due to the increase in the RCE factor.
