Key Discussion Items

- The request by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation (CMMI) was discussed. The MDPCP's Executive Director reviewed the CMMI request and the process to develop an optional Track 3, which is based on Primary Care First (PCF).
- The MDPCP Advisory Council (Council) Co-Chairs highlighted the process for presenting the draft Track 3 Committee's (Committee) recommendations to the Council before being submitted as final to CMMI for consideration.
- The Committee considered PCF program elements related to payment structure, performance measurement and care delivery. Committee members addressed the challenges and opportunities of these program elements and in some instances suggested alternative program elements to consider in Track 3.
