Staff are reviewing your calculations and findings for the MVS analysis. In your submitted response on p. 4, last paragraph, you "subtract \$56.32/sf for an "Abnormal Shortage Multiplier."

Please provide needed documentation and details with regard to the following:

1) What is the "Abnormal Shortage Multiplier" and the basis for using it? Do you have a source to verify the use of this multiplier? If so, please provide documentation and details on how other organizations use this multiplier.

2) In Exhibit 5, you indicate that this multiplier is "10%" of the MVS Cost/Square Foot. Can you document the use of 10% as an industry standard used to calculate the total construction cost to replace or reproduce the SGMC patient tower. Can this multiplier have a value that is lower than 10%?

3) Without the use of this "Abnormal Shortage Multiplier," Shady Grove's MVS benchmark value would be \$563.25 per SF (as indicated in Exhibit 5, MVS calculation) and the dollar difference between the project cost amount and the MVS benchmark would increase significantly from \$44,166,341. Justify the use of this multiplier? Is this a fixed percentage or is there a range? What factors dictate the use of 10%?
