

MONTHLY STATUS REPORT

September 1, 2019 Through October 31, 2019

The Maryland Health Care Commission, an independent agency located within the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, is responsible for planning and regulating the development of a health care system that provides Maryland residents with geographic and financial access to quality health care at a reasonable cost.

September 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019

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The Maryland Health Care Commission has announced the following decisions on applications to build, enlarge, merge, or modify health services or facilities in the State. These decisions were made from September 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019.

Decisions of this nature apply to applications from proposed providers or sponsors seeking MHCC Certification of Need as required by State Law:

During this period the following decisions were made:

- projects were approved with a cost of \$334,575
- ▶ <u>0</u> projects were denied
- ▶ _______ projects were voted upon for merger/consolidation, exemption, or declaratory ruling
- ▶ ______ project was deemed not needing Certificate of Need Review with passage of new legislation

- ▶ _____ projects under review were withdrawn by the applicant
- ▶ 0 approved projects were revoked by the Commission

Also during this period the following occurred:

- ▶ 1 new letters of intent was received
- ▶ <u>24</u> determinations of coverage for Certificate of Need review were made including waiver beds and acquisitions

The MHCC currently has 17 CON applications under review and 38 CON approved projects under development.

MHCC Certification helps assure that new or expanded facilities and services are consistent with the future health care needs of the people of Maryland. All projects certified by this Commission have been found consistent with the State Health Plan and review standard of this Commission.
