



Figure 2. Total Number of Home Health Agency Clients (Unduplicated) and Visits: Maryland, Fiscal Years 2004-2013





Figure 4. Percent Distribution of HHA Costs by Discipline: Maryland, Fiscal Years 2004 and 2013
