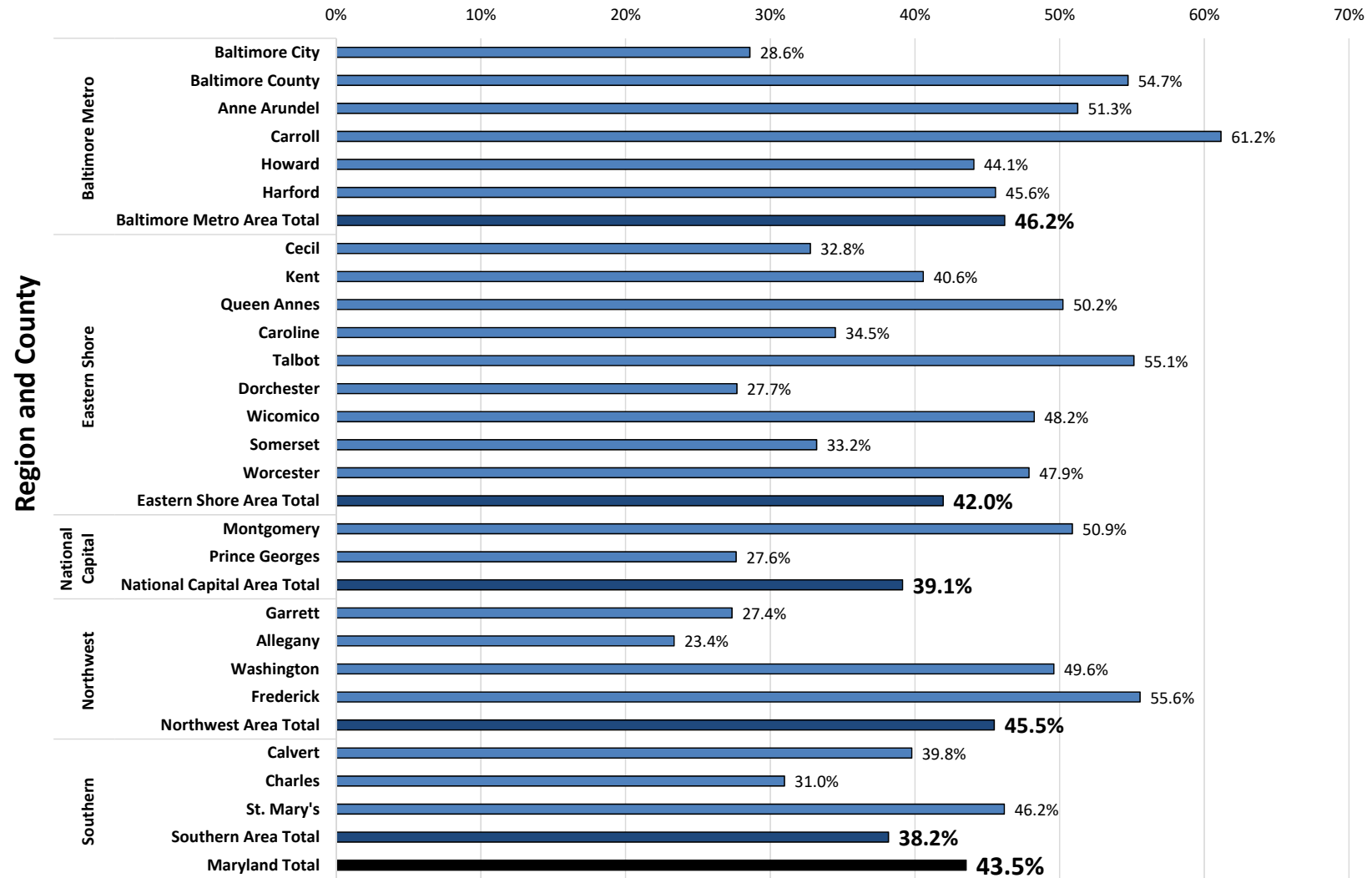

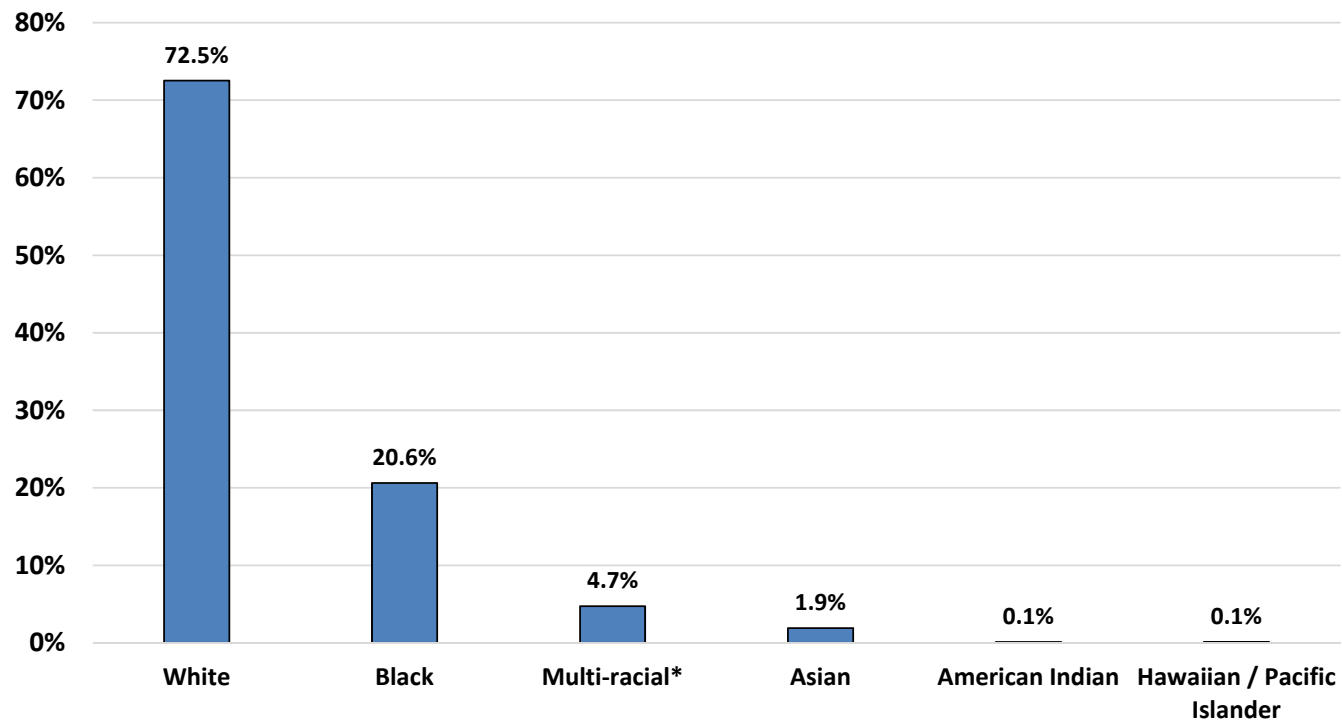

### Hospice Patients Served in Maryland by Race, 2018

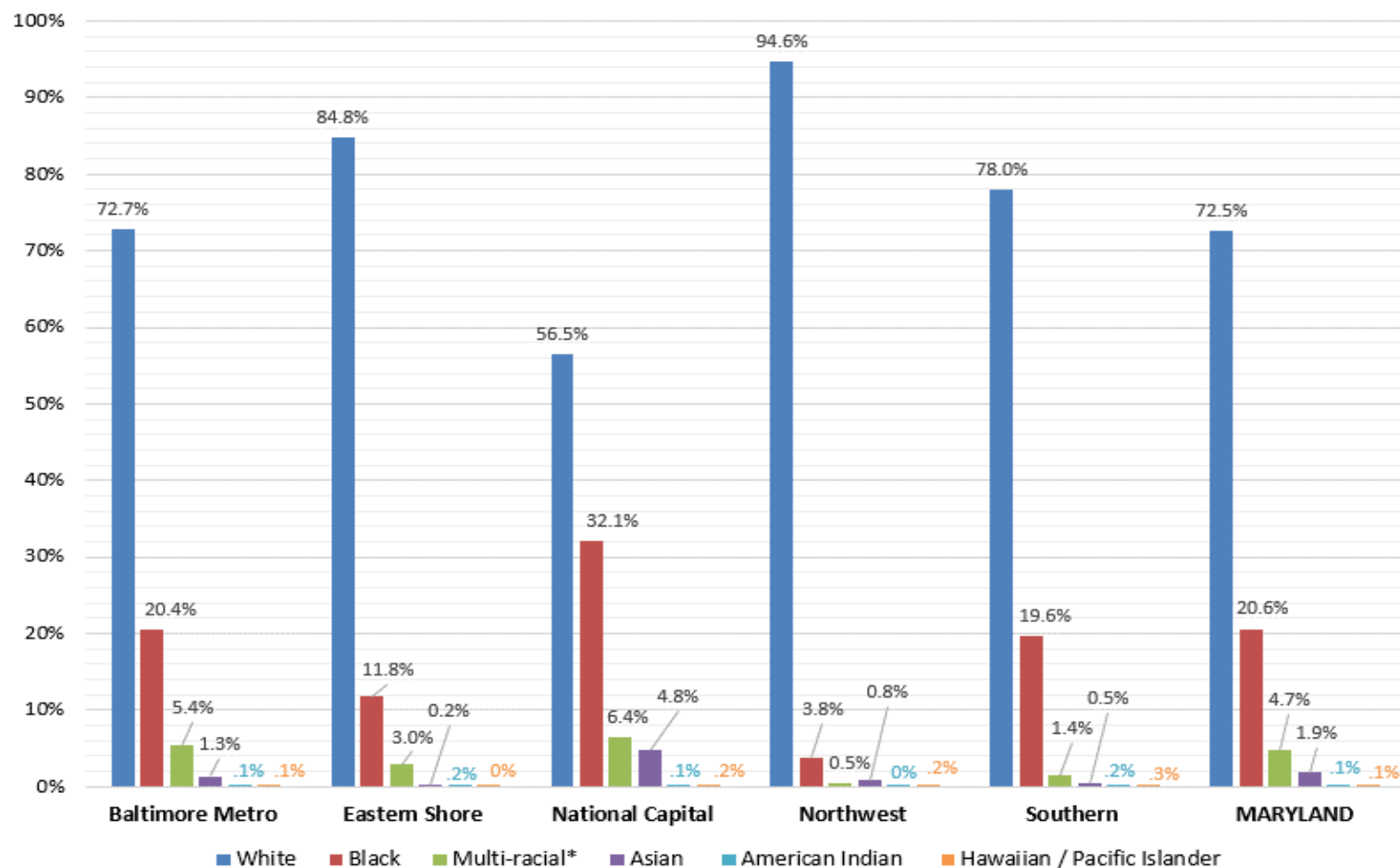

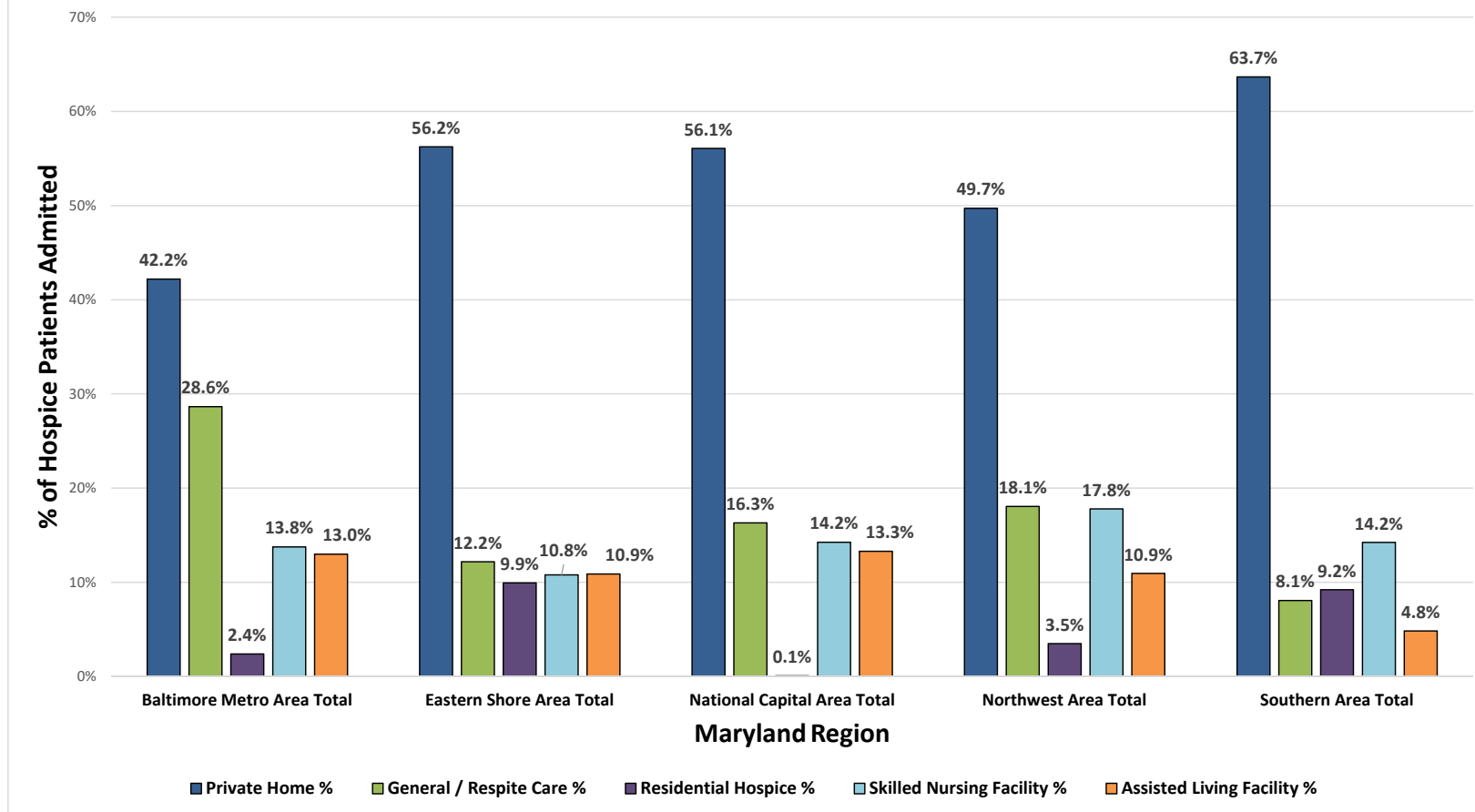

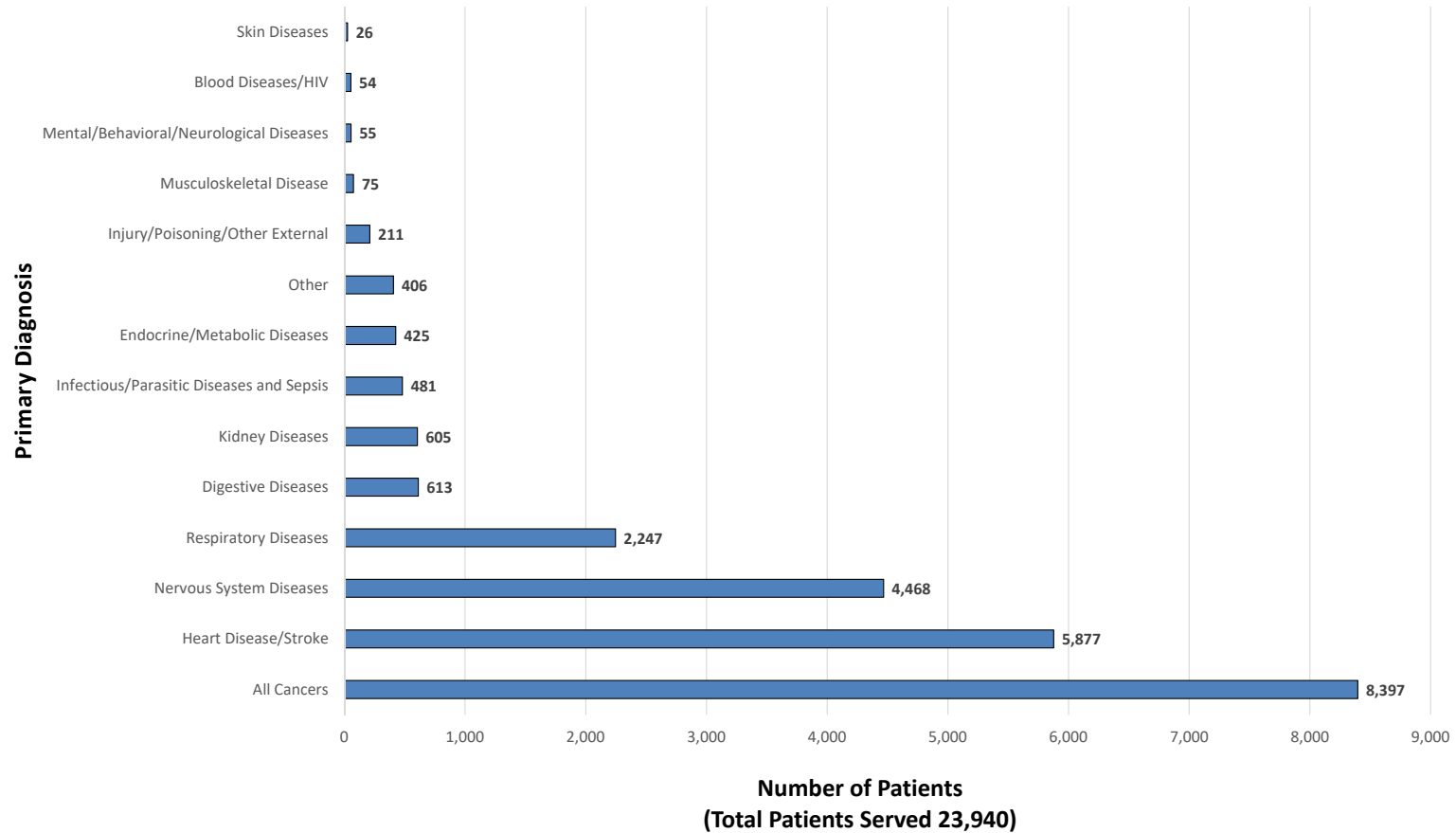
