<sup>1</sup> University of Maryland Rehabilitation and Orthopedic Institute's 52 chronic hospital beds include 16 dually licensed chronic/ rehabilitation beds.

<sup>2</sup> The 12 chronic hospital beds currently operated on the campus of the UM Prince George's Hospital Center replaced 46 chronic hospital beds formerly operated on the campus of UM Laurel Regional Hospital. The remaining 34 chronic hospital beds have been temporarily delicensed. The FY 2019 data shown in the table reflects the combined chronic hospital utilization at both sites during the fiscal year.

<sup>3</sup> Western Maryland Hospital Center's occupancy rate, based on its 19 *budgeted* chronic hospital beds, would be 54.5 percent.

<sup>4</sup> Deer's Head Hospital Center's chronic hospital occupancy rate, based on its 11 *budgeted* chronic hospital beds, would be 49.1 percent.

<sup>5</sup> The occupancy rate for the two State-operated chronic hospitals, based on the total 30 *budgeted* chronic hospital beds, would be 52.6 percent.

<sup>6</sup> The Statewide chronic hospital bed occupancy rate, based on the 320 *licensed* beds at the five *private* facilities plus the 30 *budgeted* beds at the two *State-operated* facilities would be 48.1 percent.

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
