**LEVEL II CENTERS:** Maximum hours are 24,500 per year, or 12,250 per 6 month semi annual filing period. The RCE factor increased 2.0%, as reflected by the Physician Compensation Component of the Medicare Economic Index ("MEI") calculated by averaging the factor for the first 2 quarters of the prior year, 2018, and the last 2 quarters of the year before the prior year, 2017.

**LEVEL III CENTERS:** Maximum hours are 35,040 per year or 17,520 per 6 month semi annual filing period. The RCE factor increased 2.0%, as reflected by the Physician Compensation Component of the Medicare Economic Index ("MEI") calculated by averaging the factor for the first 2 quarters of the prior year, 2018, and the last 2 quarters of the year before the prior year, 2017.
