

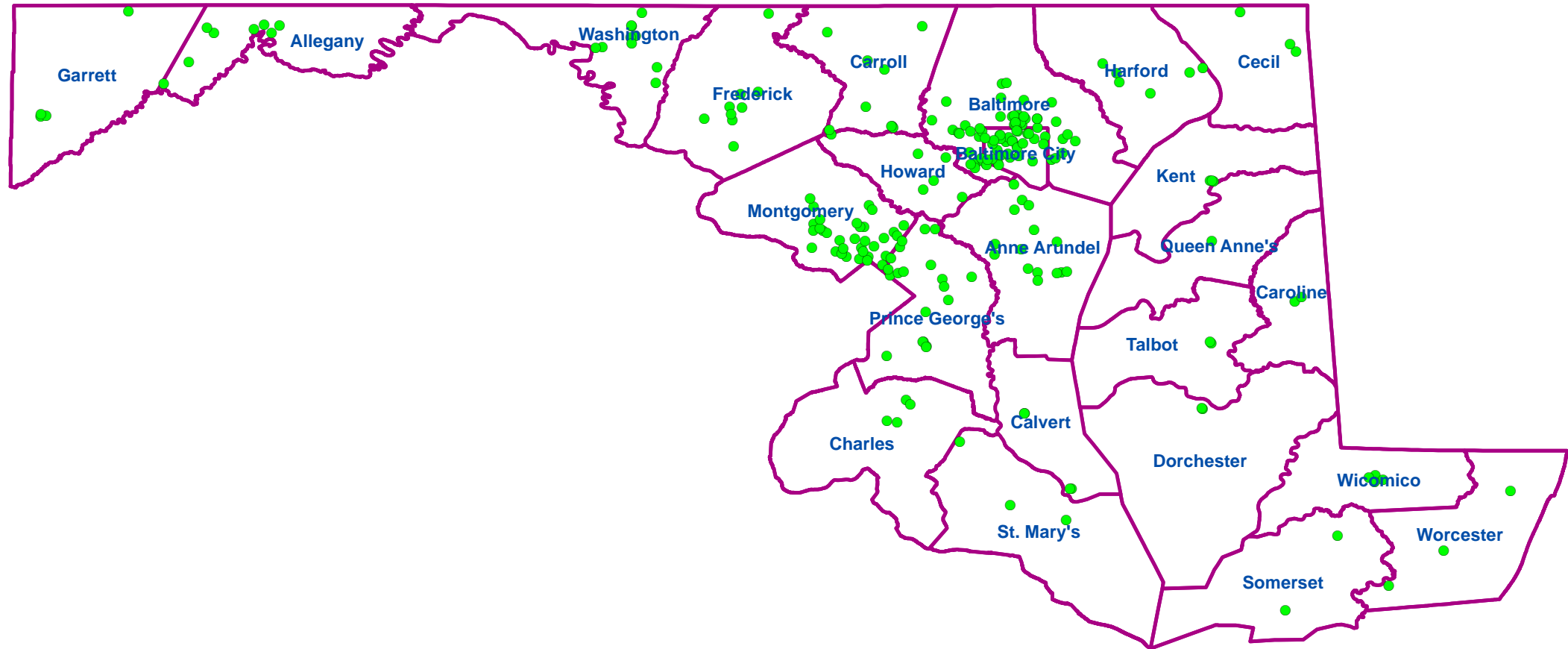

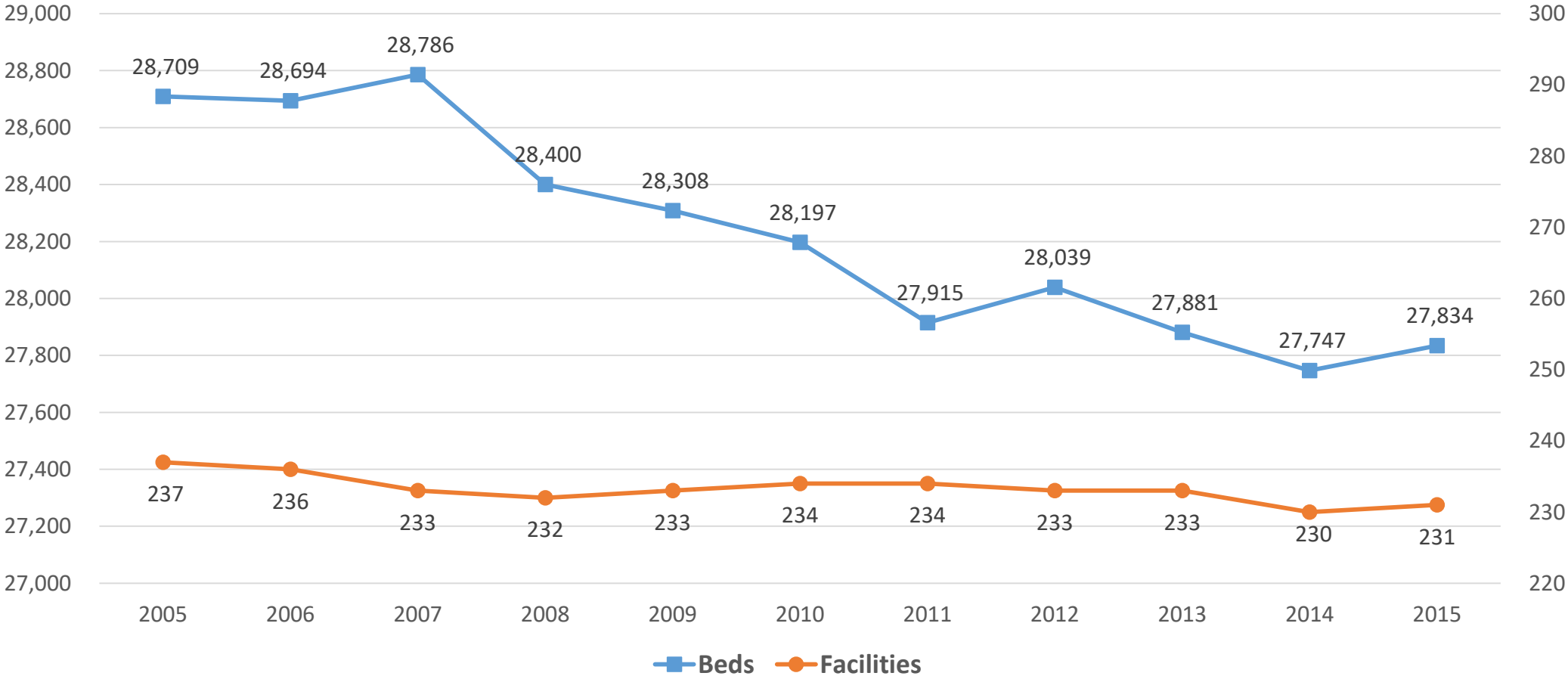

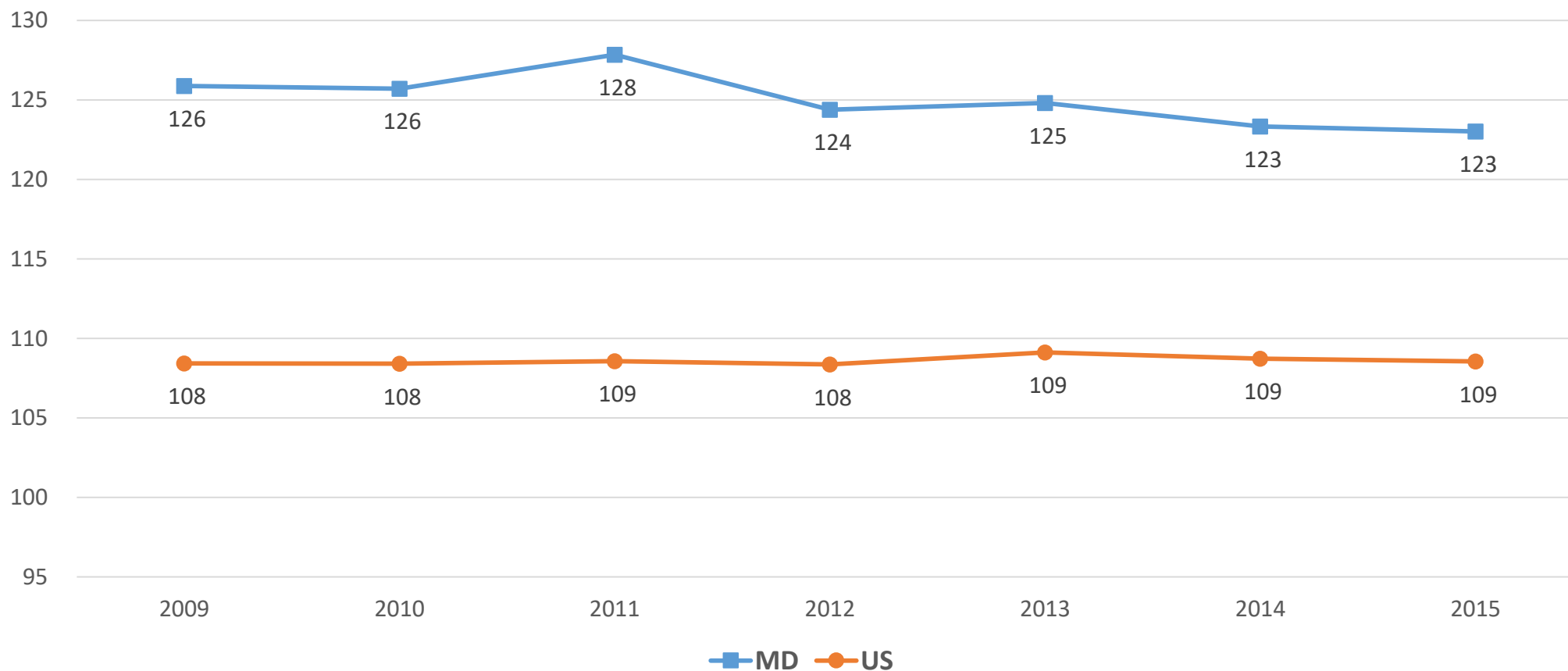

### Chart 1: Maryland Nursing Facilities and Beds 2005 - 2015



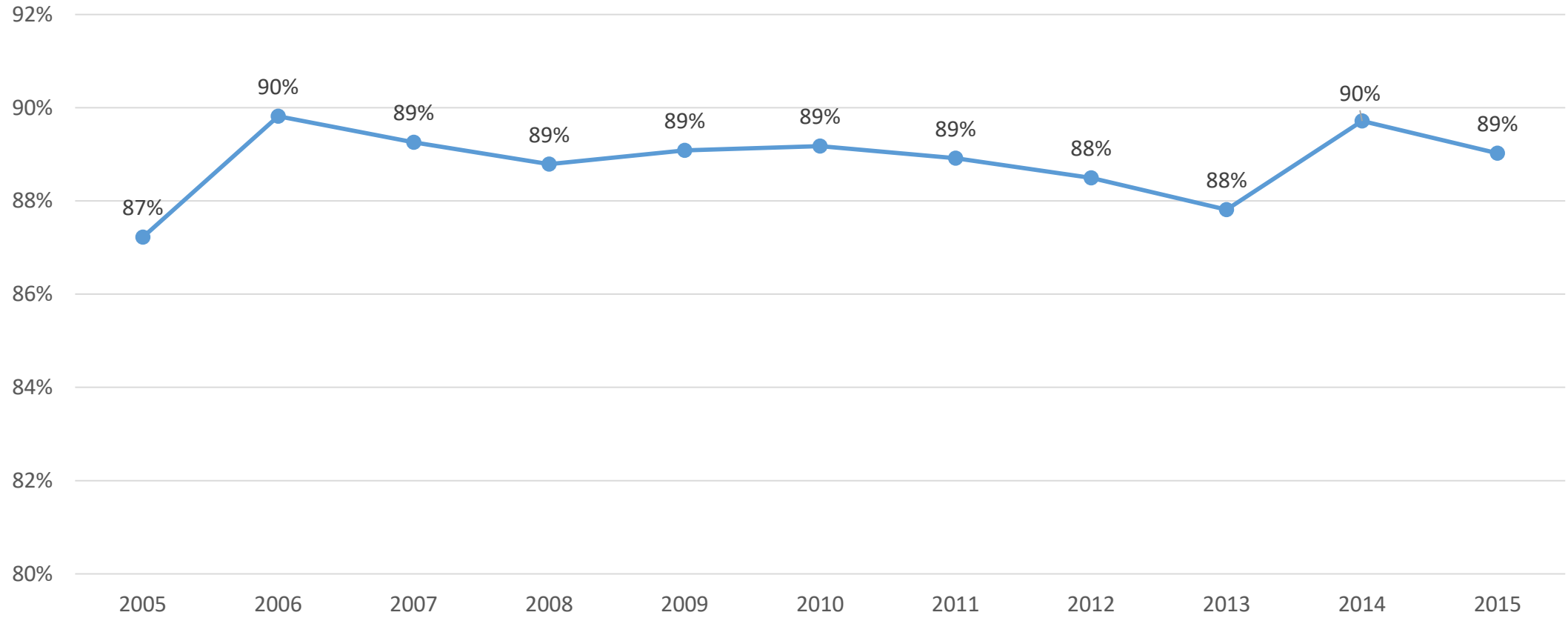

### Chart 2: Average Number of Certified Beds per Nursing Facility Maryland vs National



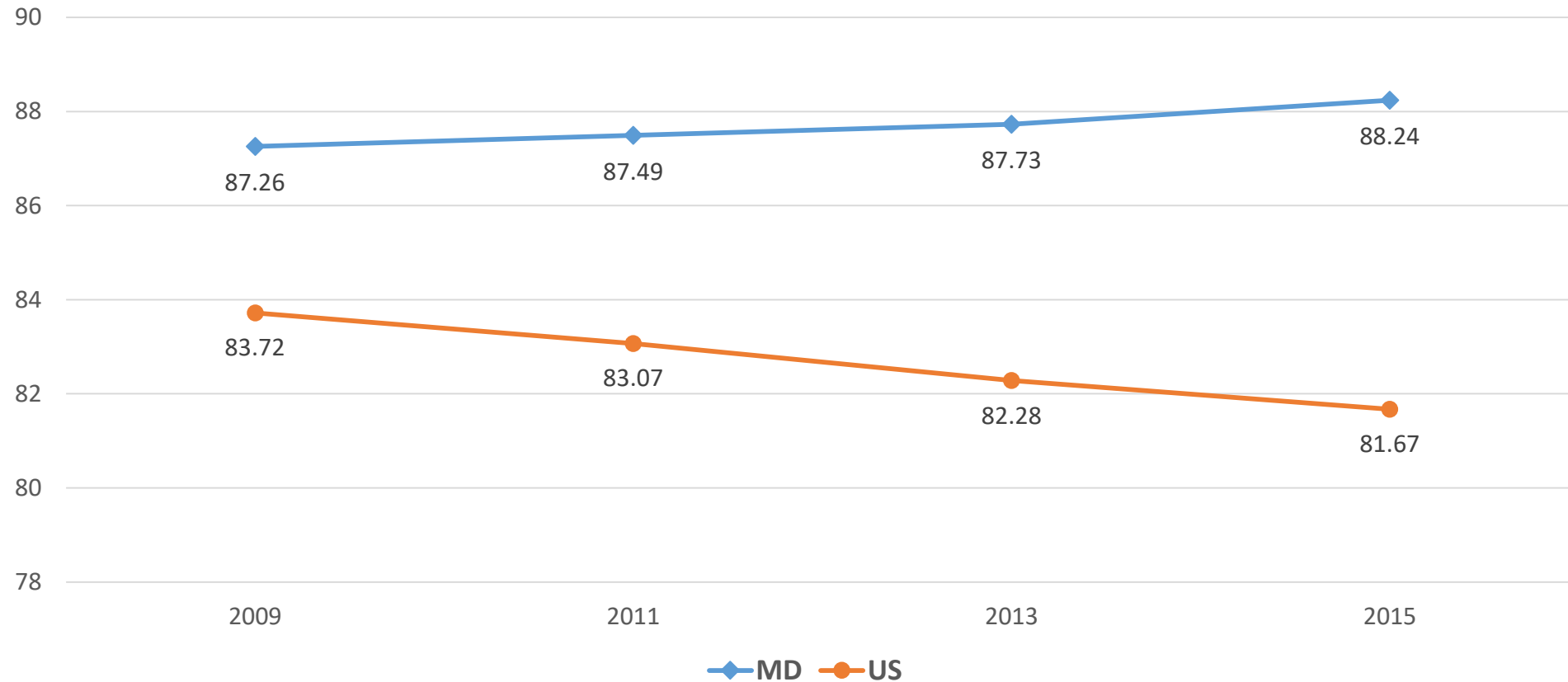

2005 - 2015**



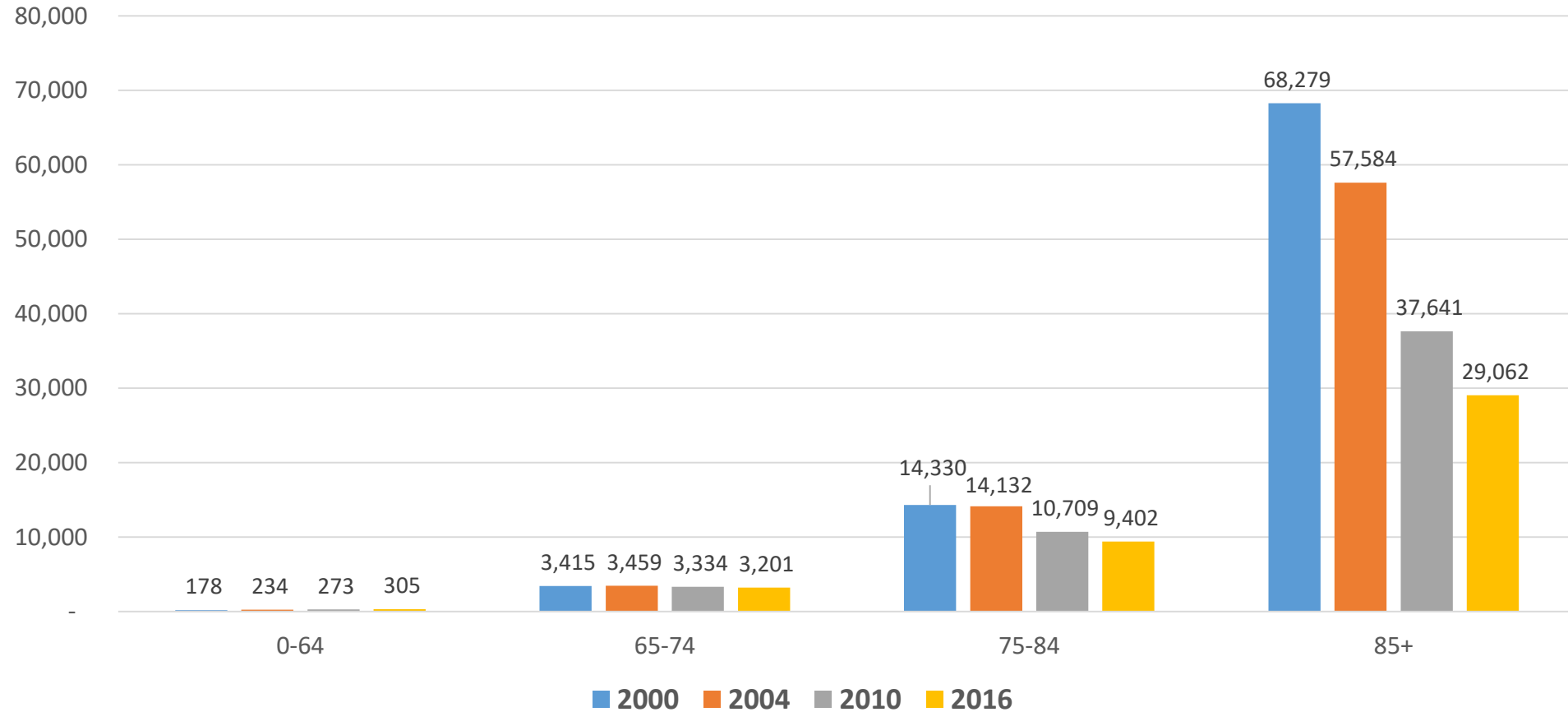

Maryland vs National**



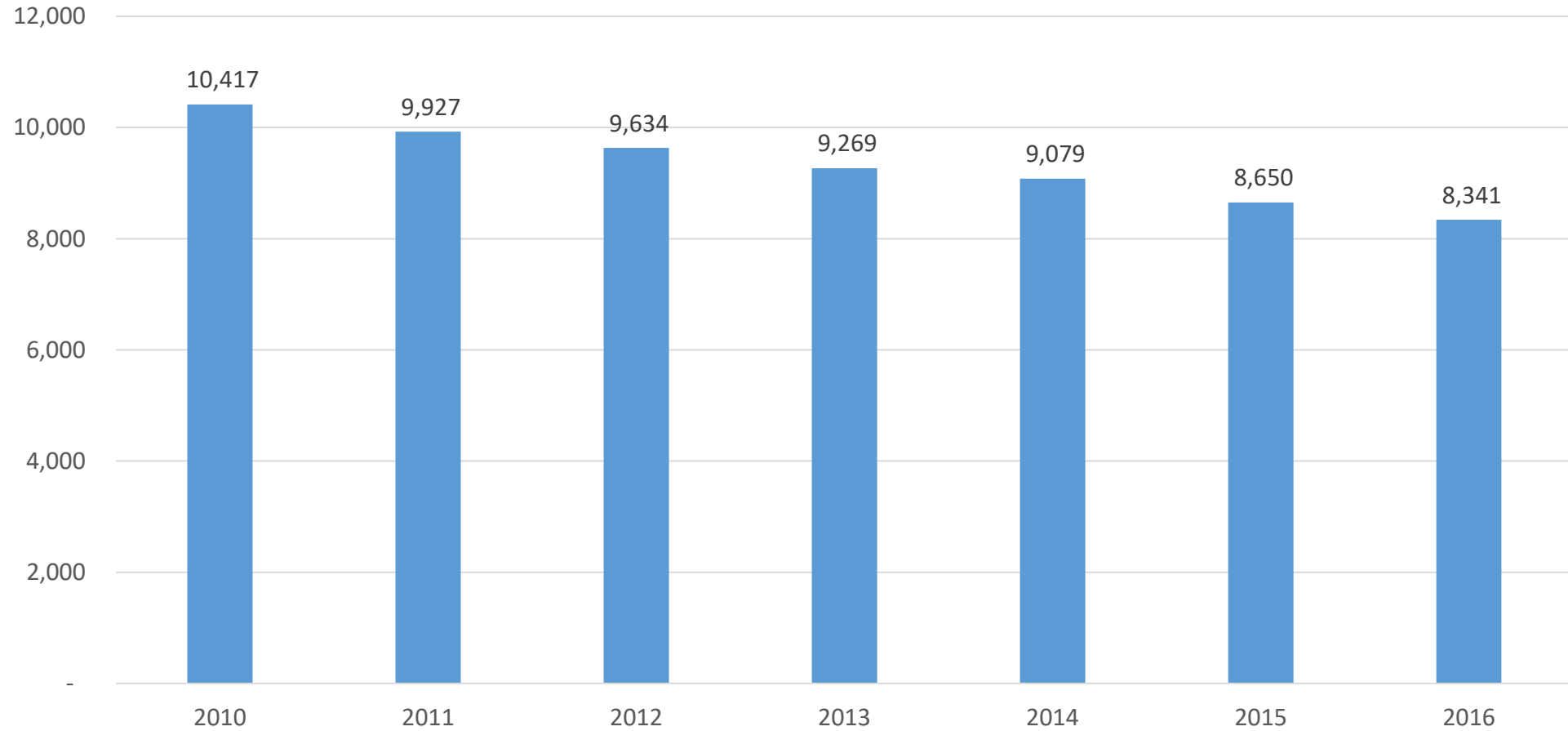

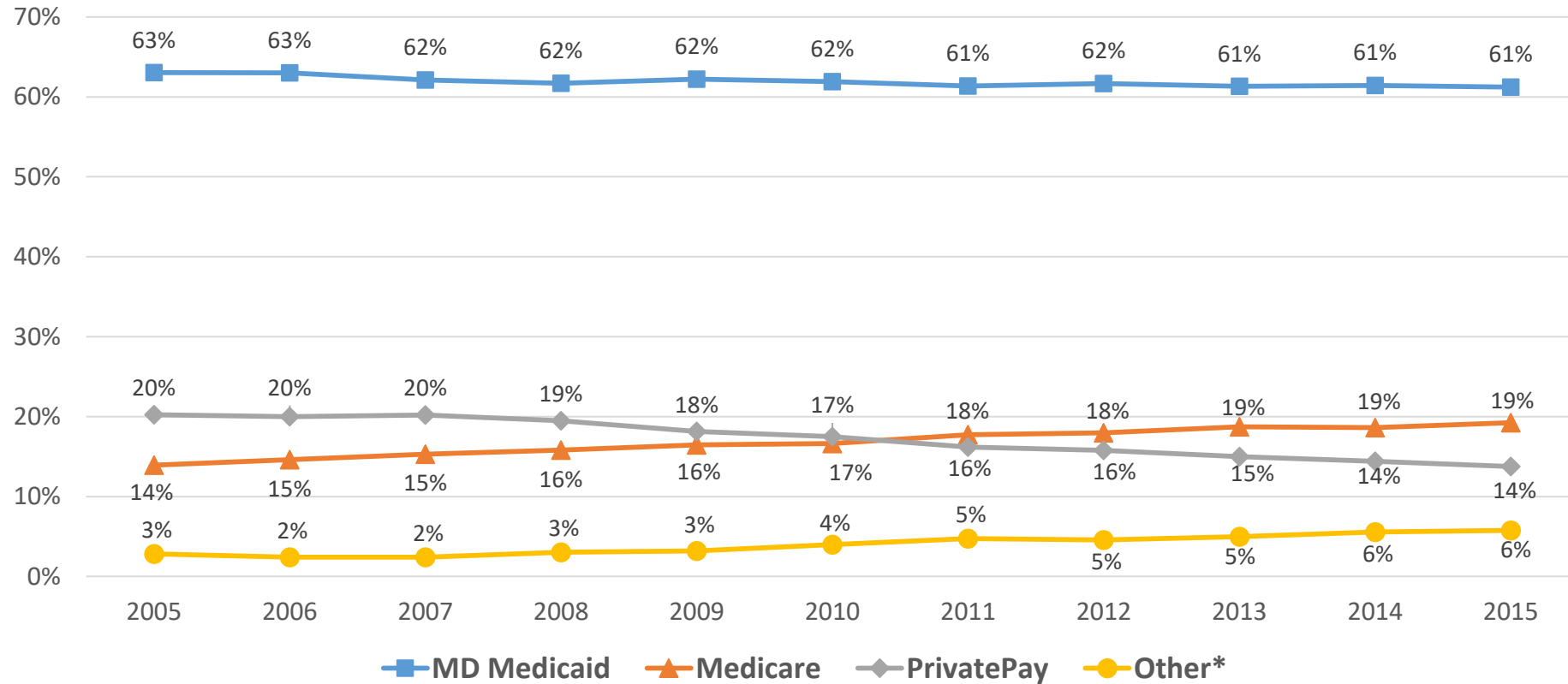
**Chart 7: Maryland Resident Nursing Facility Use Rate for Age 65+

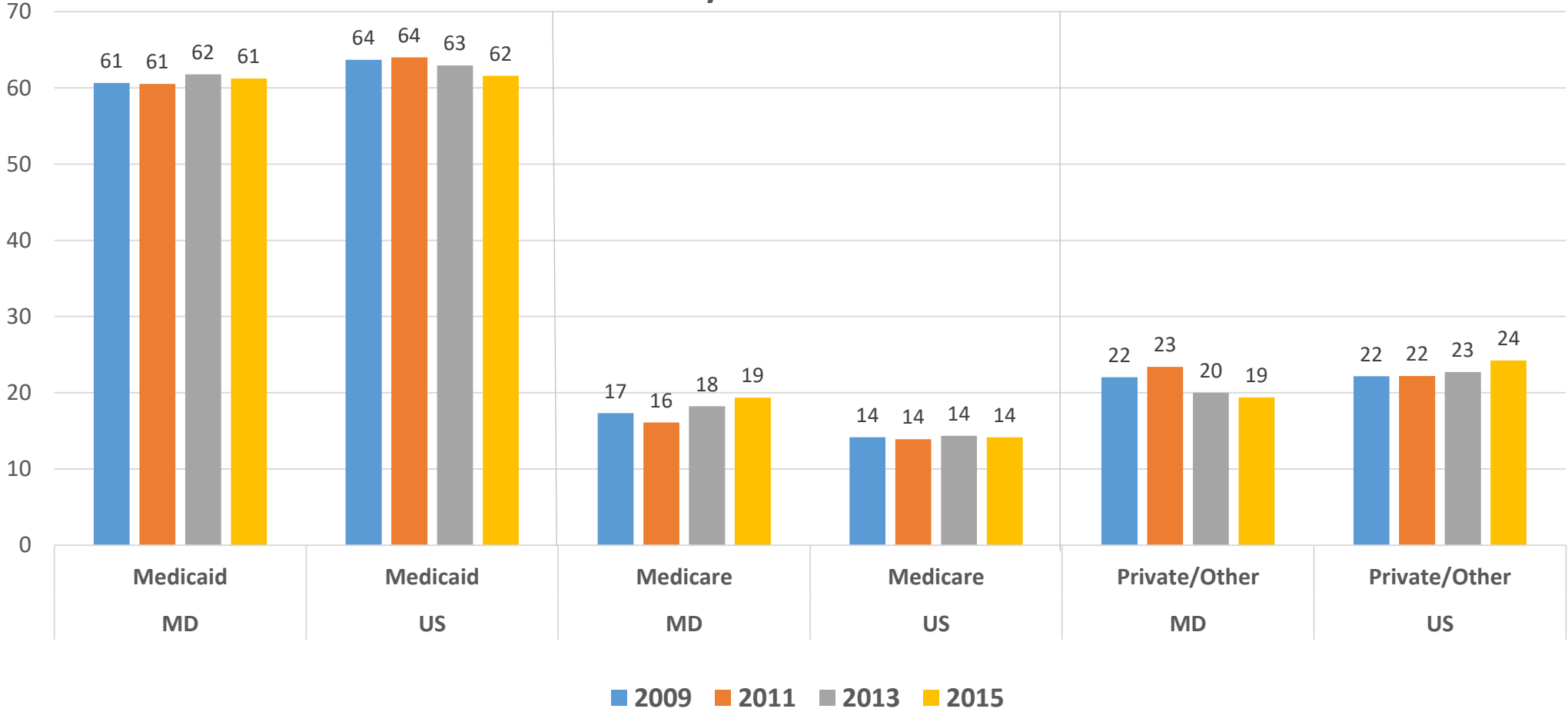
**Chart 8: Percent of Maryland Nursing Facility Patient Days by Payer

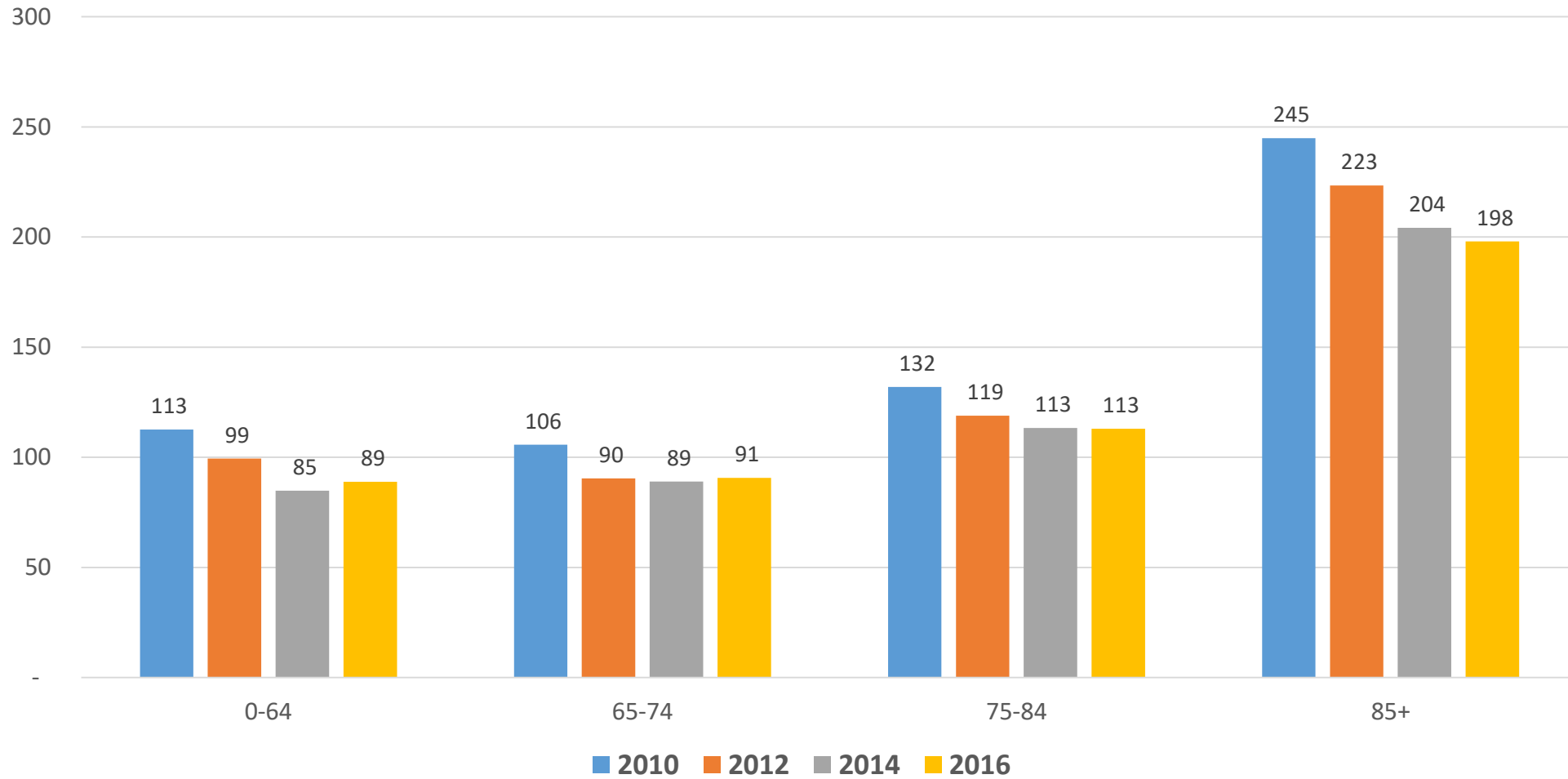
