

## Primary Care Workgroup Meeting Summary

June 21, 2023 | 5:00pm - 6:30pm

- Staff reviewed primary care investment models results for private payers in the State:
  - Narrow definition spending breakdown
  - o Module 1 Behavioral health spending
  - Module 2 Obstetrics and gynecology spending
- Staff presented key takeaways from meetings with select states that completed or are currently conducting studies to inform development of primary care investment targets
  - o Takeaways were informed by questions sent in advance to the states
  - Questions were designed to facilitate discussion on how states arrived at their approach to setting primary care investment targets and lessons learned from the process that could inform MHCC efforts
- Freedman Healthcare, LLC provided an overview of target considerations for primary care investment:
  - Voluntary target or required investment
  - Single target or target for each payer type
  - o Absolute improvement, relative improvement, or both
  - o Percent of Total Cost of Care or per member, per month amount
