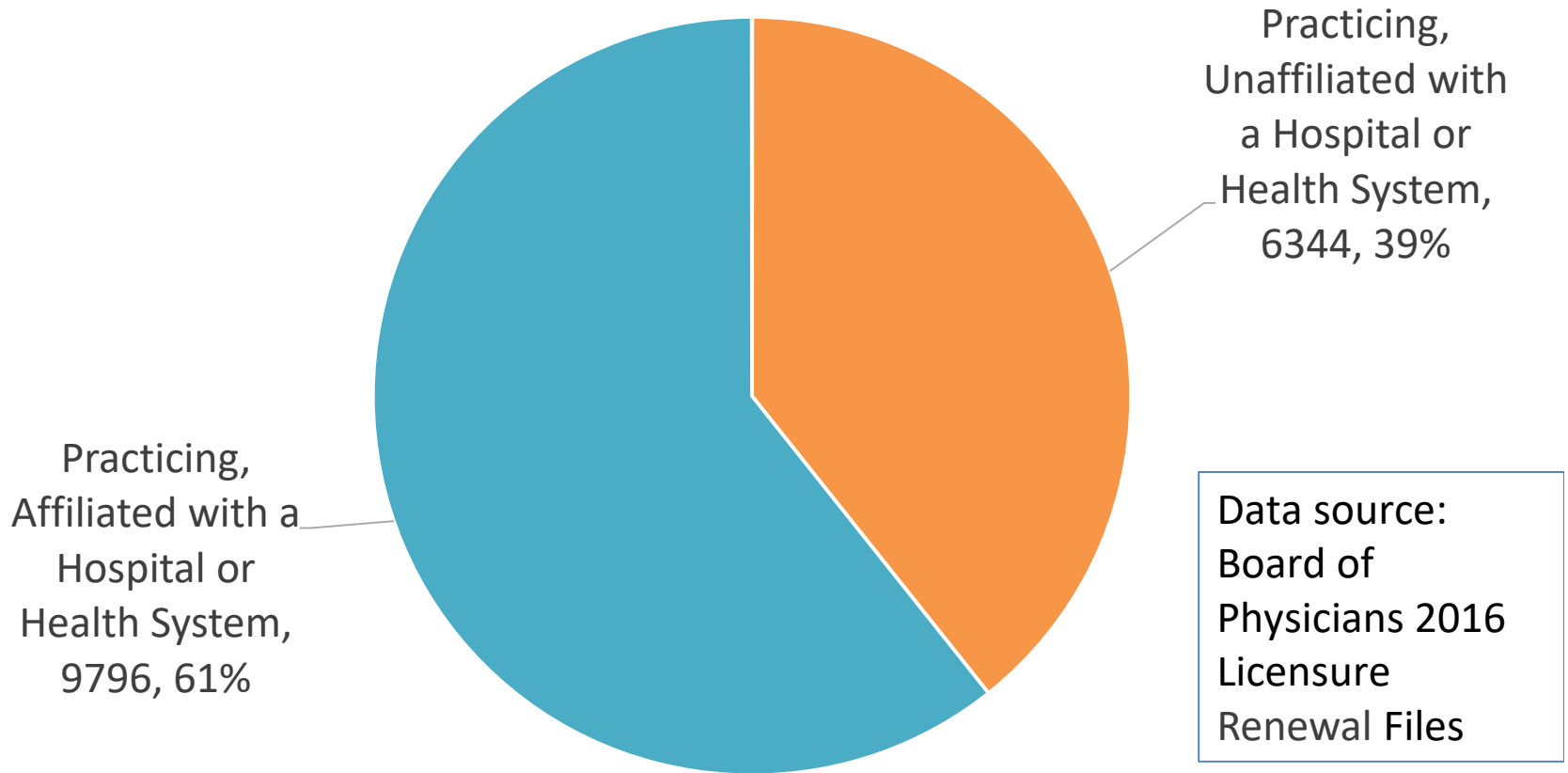

Five Out-of-State Statutes

- Effective dates: November 1, 2016 - July 1, 2018.
- 2 Approaches
 - GA, OK, SC
 - TN & TX

Discussion

- Maintain Status Quo
 - Health systems and insurers maintain current autonomy.
 - NBPAS could be recognized by health systems or insurers. NBPAS could apply to Board of Physicians for recognition.
- Policy Proposal
 - Hospitals: TX style language-cannot require MOC unless need for accreditation or vote of Medical staff and board.
 - Insurers: No change from status quo, since limited use of board certification. Insurers would have discretion in requirements for board certification.
 - No change to Title 14 on physician professional regulation re: MOC or NPBAS
- Legislate Physician Autonomy
 - Individual physicians decide on board certification and MOC.
 - Significant change to Title 14 on physician professional regulation re: MOC and perhaps NPBAS.
