# MDPCP Overview

- ▶ A voluntary program under Maryland's Total Cost of Care (TCOC) open to all qualifying Maryland primary care providers
- ▶ Provides funding and support for the delivery of advanced primary care
- ▶ Supports health care transformation by enabling primary care providers to have an increased role in preventing and managing chronic disease and reducing unnecessary hospital utilization
- ▶ The program is an alternative payment model, which is a care delivery and payment model that incentivizes high quality care



# Advisory Council - Key Activities

- ▶ Make recommendations for inclusion in the State's annual report to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services on MDPCP
- ▶ Consider operational improvements to the MDPCP, including suggested modifications to the care delivery requirements
- ▶ Gather data from MDPCP participants and beneficiaries to support research
- ▶ Request other Maryland Department of Health agencies to examine specific issues



# MHCC's Role

Staff provides administrative management and support services:

- ▶ Convening the Advisory Council
- ▶ Selecting representatives and making recommendations on reappointments, in consultation with the Program Management Office and the Health Services Cost Review Commission
- ▶ Researching issues under consideration by the Advisory Council
- ▶ Examining specific issues in the TCOC Model or the Medicaid Program that affect the MDPCP, as requested by the Advisory Council

# Primary Care Representative - Nominee



## **James Trumble, MD, MBA**

Dr. Trumble is a board-certified emergency medicine physician and senior physician executive with more than 20 years of progressive leadership experience in health care with extensive involvement in clinical integration, utilization, quality management, performance improvement, physician education, community health, and the continuum of care. He serves as the Vice President for Clinical Integration at TidalHealth. Dr. Trumble supports the integration of population health and value-based care programs with employed and independent area practices.

In addition to his work at TidalHealth, Dr. Trumble provides addiction medicine services as a staff physician at McCready Medical Facility and clinical care for isolated patients on Smith Island. Prior to joining TidalHealth, he was the Medical Director, Physician Utilization and Vice-Chair, Emergency Medicine at Frederick Memorial Hospital.
