# Meritus Medical Center



## Summary of Condition

Hold meetings at least every other month for the purpose of conducting interventional case review that include physicians, technologists, and nurses who care for primary PCI patients, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(a).

Submit to MHCC staff attendance lists for each of these hospital staff meetings held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July and December by February 1 of each year until at least February 1, 2022.

## Information Submitted and Staff Analysis

The hospital has provided documentation of the meetings held and attendees at meetings for two years, CY 2021 and CY 2022. Meetings were held six times each year, every other month. It has demonstrated compliance with the condition.

Hold meetings at least every other month for the purpose of conducting interventional case review that include physicians, technicians, and nurses who care for primary PCI patients, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(a).

Submit to MHCC staff attendance lists for each meeting held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July and December by February 1 of each year.

Hold monthly multiple care area group meetings, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(b).

Submit to MHCC staff attendance lists for each meeting held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July to December by February 1 of each year.

Maintain a formal continuing medical education (CME) program, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(4)(g).

Submit to the Commission documentation of participation in CME activities by the CCL staff and CCU staff for the period of January to June by August 1 of each year and documentation of CME activities for the period of July to December by February 1 of each year.

The hospital has provided documentation of the case review meetings held and attendees at meetings for CY 2021 and CY 2022. Six meetings were held in CY 2021; seven meetings were held in CY 2022. It has demonstrated compliance with the condition.

The hospital provided detailed information on CME activities, including dates, participants, and a description of the activities for CY 2021 and CY 2022.



# Adventist White Oak Medical Center

## Information Submitted and Staff Analysis

Hold bi-monthly interventional case review meetings, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(a).

Submit to MHCC staff attendance lists for each meeting held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July and December by February 1 of each year until at least February 1, 2023.

The hospital provided documentation of meetings held in CY 2022. The same group that meets monthly also is used to meet the requirement for case review meetings. Ten meetings were held in CY 2022.

Hold monthly multiple care area group meetings, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(b).

Submit to Commission staff attendance lists for each of these meetings held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July and December by February 1 of each year until at least February 1, 2023.

The hospital provided documentation of ten meetings held in CY 2022. The documentation provided included lists of attendees and meeting materials. The March and November meetings were canceled.

# Suburban Hospital

Hold monthly multiple care area group meetings, as required in COMAR 10.24.17.07D(5)(b).

Submit to Commission staff attendance lists for each of these meetings held between January and June by August 1 of each year and attendance lists for meetings held between July and December by February 1 of each year until at least February 1, 2023.

The hospital provided meeting dates and attendees for all meetings held between January 2022 and January 2023.
